For some of us, a more sensible choice may be to pre-plan our final resting places. When a death occurs, it is a traumatic time which carries with it considerable emotional and financial strain on our families and loved ones. Pre-planning will eliminate this burden on those we love, and ensure that the Catholic traditions which we have held dear to us throughout our lives will be continued on in our final resting place.

However, due to the limited remaining inventory of gravesites at St. John Cemetery, Mt. St. Mary Cemetery and Holy Cross Cemetery, gravesites are only available to families having an immediate need. Mausoleum crypts and cremation niches are available on a pre-need basis at all locations.
